
Debate is a way to argue equally without losing our tempers.

- 5. The Properties


Our section belong to K.E.L.U.(Kansai English Language Union). We participate in some events of K.E.L.U. as a part of our activities.



In summer training camp we had an orientation in English. We had a lot of fun and made good memories.


